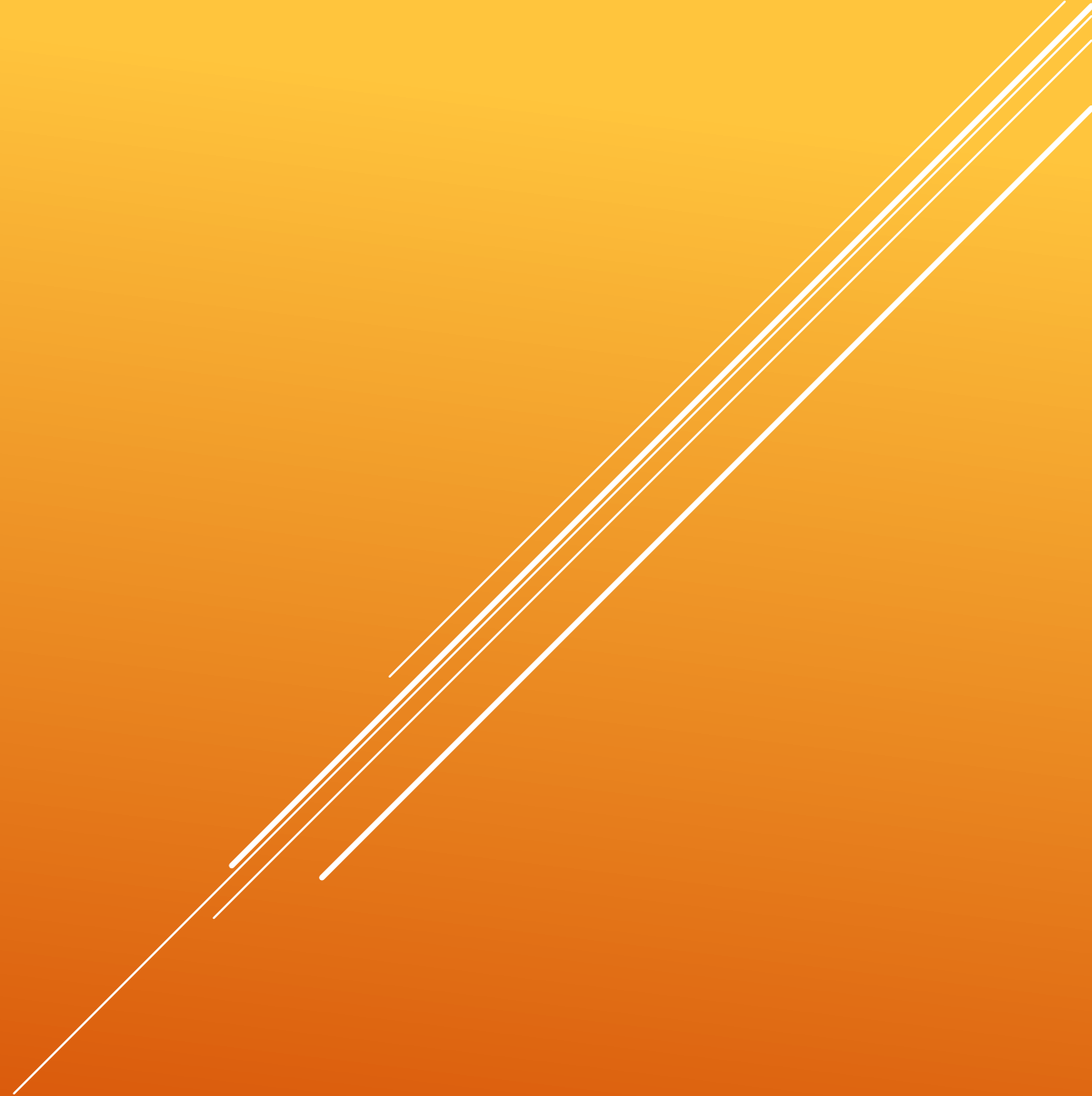

What are its basic components?


Its basic components are ...

- ▶ Susan wants to know what its basic components are.
- ▶ Her teacher says (that) **its basic components are**
 - ▶ the National Clandestine Service,
 - ▶ the Directorate of Intelligence,
 - ▶ the Directorate of Science and Technology, and
 - ▶ the Directorate of Support.



What is its primary mission?

Its primary mission is to collect, analyze, evaluate and disseminate foreign intelligence to assist...

- ▶ John wants to know what its primary mission is.
 - ▶ His teacher says (that) **its primary mission is** to collect, analyze, evaluate and disseminate foreign intelligence to assist the President and senior US policymakers in making decisions relating to national security.

What do they do, how do they collect information?



First, they have to identify the problem, then they have to study and intelligence issue...

- ▶ Peter wants to know what they do and how they collect the information.
- ▶ His teacher says (that) first **they have to identify** a problem, then **they have to study** an intelligence issue, **they translate** various articles and broadcasts, **various analysts write** their reports...



Do they make
policy
recommendations?

No, they don't make policy
recommendations.

- ▶ John wants to know if they make policy recommendations.
- ▶ His teacher says that they don't make policy recommendations, it is left to agencies such as the State Department and the Department of Defense.
